The purpose of the *Affidavit of Financial Support* is to ensure the University of Mississippi obtains complete and accurate information about the fiscal resources available to international applicants admitted to the University as required by U.S. federal regulations related to issuance of Form I-20 (for F-1 visa status) or DS-2019 (for J-1 visa status). International student must provide evidence of fiscal resources as follows:

- **Undergraduate and graduate** students (with the exception of Law and MBA): minimum **\$29,850.00**
- **MBA** (Master of Business Administration): minimum **\$39,968.00**
- **Law** (J.D. or Juris Doctorate) students: minimum **\$40,671.00**

International students are required to have a plan in place to support their costs of study (including living expenses) during the full duration of their studies at the University.

- Payment of tuition and fees for the first semester of enrollment is due on the day of class registration.
- Funds to cover costs of tuition, fees, accommodation, meals, books etc. must be available at the start of each academic semester.
- The University levels a 1 ½ percent monthly service fee on unpaid balances on past-due accounts.
- On-campus employment is not guaranteed and should not be counted as a seen as a significant means of support while at the university

The total estimated cost that must be shown on the Affidavit of Financial Support does not include tuition, international service charges, or books for the summer sessions. If a student wishes to attend classes during the summer sessions, summer tuition for 6 credit hours, books (\$200), and fees (\$60) are estimated to be an additional \$4,326.50 for undergraduate study or \$5,681 for graduate study. Per credit hour cost for summer study is \$677.75 / hr. for undergraduate study and \$903.50 / hr. for graduate study.
