INTERNATIONAL UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION **The University of Mississippi**

Information on Scholarships for International Undergraduate Students (New starting Fall 2012)

International students who are admitted to the university as degree-seeking undergraduate students, and who will hold a temporary visa/status in the USA may be considered for various international student scholarships. Scholarships are partial and limited, and thus competitive. They are generally offered on the basis of a student's academic merit, compelling aspirations and promise of success at the university.

Scholarships are generally offered for enrollment during the fall term, are non-deferrable and non-transferrable, and are renewable for up to three academic years after the academic year during which the scholarship is first awarded (total of 4 academic years), towards a first bachelor's degree only, provided academic progression and grade requirements are met, and lawful presence in the USA is maintained.

Scholarships are generally credited towards non-resident fees and resident tuition fees. They may be combined with other scholarships, but may not exceed the full non-resident fee or resident tuition.

Permanent Residents of the USA who are FAFSA-eligible may not qualify for the scholarships listed below.

For International Freshman Students Only

\$15,968 Academic Excellence Award for International Students – per academic year

- High School cumulative grade point average of 3.90 or higher on a 4.00-scale;
- Be an international student and attend/have attended a high school/secondary school abroad;
- Have graduated from a high school/secondary school abroad prior to enrolling at UM¹;
- English language proficiency scores of 79 TOEFL-IBT, 6.00 IELTS, 53 PTE-A, B grade on UM's Intensive English Program's Advanced Plus Course, or qualify for a waiver of the English proficiency test requirement;
- Approved application for admission;
- Admitted to a University of Mississippi undergraduate degree program as a degree-seeking student on a temporary visa/status in the USA;
- Scholarship Application not required.

\$9,000 Academic Excellence Award for International Students – per academic year

- High School cumulative grade point average between 3.75 and 3.89 on a 4.00-scale;
- Be an international student and attend/have attended a high school/secondary school abroad;
- Have graduated from a high school/secondary school abroad prior to enrolling at UM²;
- English language proficiency scores of 79 TOEFL-IBT, 6.00 IELTS, 53 PTE-A, B grade on UM's Intensive English Program's Advanced Plus Course, or qualify for a waiver of the English proficiency test requirement;
- Approved application for admission;
- Admitted to a University of Mississippi undergraduate degree program as a degree-seeking student on a temporary visa/status in the USA;
- Scholarship Application not required.

\$6,000 Academic Excellence Award for International Students – per academic year

- High School cumulative grade point average between 3.50 and 3.74 on a 4.00-scale;
- Be an international student and attend/have attended a high school/secondary school abroad;
- Have graduated from a high school/secondary school abroad prior to enrolling at UM³;
- English language proficiency scores of 79 TOEFL-IBT, 6.00 IELTS, 53 PTE-A, B grade on UM's Intensive English Program's Advanced Plus Course, or qualify for a waiver of the English proficiency test requirement;
- Approved application for admission;
- Admitted to a University of Mississippi undergraduate degree program as a degree-seeking student on a temporary visa/status in the USA;
- Scholarship Application not required.

\$3,250 Academic Excellence Award for International Students – per academic year

- High School cumulative grade point average between 3.50 and 3.74 on a 4.00-scale;
- Be an international student and attend/have attended a high school/secondary school abroad;
- Have graduated from a high school/secondary school abroad prior to enrolling at UM⁴;
- English language proficiency scores of 79 TOEFL-IBT, 6.00 IELTS, 53 PTE-A, B grade on UM's Intensive English Program's Advanced Plus Course, or qualify for a waiver of the English proficiency test requirement;
- Approved application for admission;
- Admitted to a University of Mississippi undergraduate degree program as a degree-seeking student on a temporary visa/status in the USA;
- Scholarship Application not required;
- Renewable for a total of 4 academic years provided the student maintains a minimum grade point average of 3.00 on UM's 4.00 scale on at least 12 credits each term and lawful presence in the USA is maintained.

\$3,000 International Undergraduate Student Scholarship for Freshman Students – per academic year

- High School cumulative grade point average between 3.00 and 3.24 on a 4.00-scale;
- Be an international student and attend/have attended a high school/secondary school abroad;
- Have graduated from a high school/secondary school abroad prior to enrolling at UM⁵;
- English language proficiency scores of 79 TOEFL-IBT, 6.00 IELTS, 53 PTE-A, B grade on UM's Intensive English Program's Advanced Plus Course, or qualify for a waiver of the English proficiency test requirement;
- Approved application for admission;
- Admitted to a University of Mississippi undergraduate degree program as a degree-seeking student on a temporary visa/status in the USA;
- Competitive Award. International Undergraduate Student Scholarship Application is required!
- Scholarship Application deadline is March 1 for Fall enrollment an September 15 for Spring enrollment.
- International Undergraduate Student Scholarships are non-deferrable and valid only with enrollment in the start-term for which it was awarded. Such scholarships are credited towards non-resident fees and may be combined with other Non-Resident Fee Scholarships, not exceeding the full non-resident fees.

- Renewable for a total of 4 academic years provided the student maintains a minimum grade point average of 3.00 on UM's 4.00 scale on at least 12 credits each term, lawful presence in the USA is maintained and volunteerism and engagement in campus life are demonstrated.

For International Transfer Students Only

Up to max \$10,968 International Undergraduate Student Scholarship for Transfer Students – per academic year

- Cumulative U.S. equivalent grade point average on all higher education courses completed must be 3.00 or higher on a 4.00-scale;
- English language proficiency scores of 79 TOEFL-IBT, 6.00 IELTS, 53 PTE-A, B grade on UM's Intensive English Program's Advanced Plus Course, or qualify for a waiver of the English proficiency test requirement;
- Approved application for admission;
- Admitted to a University of Mississippi undergraduate degree program as a transferring degree-seeking student on a temporary visa/status in the USA;
- Competitive Award. International Undergraduate Student Scholarship Application is required!
- Scholarship Application deadline is March 1 for Fall enrollment and September 15 for Spring enrollment.
- International Undergraduate Student Scholarships are non-deferrable and valid only with enrollment in the start-term for which it was awarded. Such scholarships are credited towards non-resident fees and may be combined with other Non-Resident Fee Scholarships, not exceeding the full non-resident fees.
- Renewable for a total of 4 academic years provided the student maintains a minimum grade point average of 3.00 on UM's 4.00 scale on at least 12 credits each term, lawful presence in the USA is maintained and volunteerism and engagement in campus life are demonstrated.

For Enrolled International Students at the University of Mississippi Only

\$1,000 International Undergraduate Student Scholarship – per academic year In recognition of Excellence at the University of Mississippi

- Cumulative grade point average on all courses attempted of 3.75 or higher on UM's 4.00-scale;
- Completion of at least 60 course credits, not including Intensive English Program (IEP) courses other than IE100, at the University of Mississippi's main Oxford campus;
- Have been consecutively enrolled at the University of Mississippi in an undergraduate degree program;
- Essay;
- Submission of University of Mississippi transcripts;
- Competitive Award. International Undergraduate Student Scholarship Application is required!
- Scholarship Application deadline is June 1. Scholarships are awarded in Summer prior to a Fall term only.
- International Undergraduate Student Scholarships for Enrolled International Students in Recognition of their Excellence at the University of Mississippi are credited towards resident tuition fees and may be combined with other scholarships, but may not exceed the full resident tuition.
- Renewable for a total of 2 academic years provided the student maintains a minimum grade point average of 3.75 on UM's 4.00 scale on at least 15 credits each term, lawful presence in the USA is maintained, and volunteerism and engagement in campus life are demonstrated.
