



## Extension of I-20 for Intensive English Students

### Requirements for Extension:

1. Student must be deemed as having made progress in the IEP program and intend to continue as a full time student in the University of Mississippi's Intensive English Program.
2. Evidence that is not more than 6 months old of sufficient funding for tuition and living expenses for the period of extension must be on file.
3. Extension must be requested and processed before the expiration date of the current I-20. Allow time for processing by turning in documents at least two weeks prior to the end date listed in number 5 of the current I-20.
